

# Provisional Ballot Survey

## *Wyoming*

Provisional Ballots Cast: 95  
Provisional Ballots Counted: 24  
Percent Counted: 25.3%  
Percent of Vote: 0.01%

PLEASE NOTE: Wyoming has Election Day registration. Provisional ballots are used if the voter does not have the required proof of identity when attempting to register on Election Day.

### **DESIGN**

#### **Who designs the provisional ballot, the state or county?**

Local jurisdictions design the ballots and the state designs the provisional ballot envelope.

#### **Is the entity responsible for designing the provisional ballot designated by statute or rule?**

The ballots are regular ballots.

#### **Does Utah have a provisional ballot that also serves as a voter registration application?**

No, Wyoming does not have a combined provisional ballot/registration application.

#### **Is Utah's provisional ballot visually distinguishable from a regular ballot?**

Provisional ballots regular ballots.

### **AVAILABILITY AND STANDARDS**

#### **Is there a required number of provisional ballots at polling places?**

Regulars ballots also serve as provisional ballots.

#### **What to do poll workers do if the polling place runs out of provisional ballots?**

N/A

#### **Are provisional ballots tracked through distribution to polling sites through counting?**

Yes, provisional ballots are given a unique identifier.

## **COUNTING PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

### **Who determines whether or not a provisional ballot is valid?**

State law designates the County Canvassing Board determines whether or not the provisional ballot is valid.

### **What is the time frame for counting provisional ballots?**

Determination must be made no later than the first Friday following the election, according to state law.

### **What is the process for determining the eligibility of a provisional ballot?**

The Board reviews and determines the eligibility of each provisional voter according to state statute.

### **Who can observe the process?**

Only the canvassing board can observe the process.

### **Is a provisional ballot counted if it is cast in the wrong precinct?**

No, a provisional ballot is counted only if cast in the correct precinct.

### **What information must voters provide on the provisional ballot?**

Voters must provide identification to register on Election Day, or be able to bring proper identification by the close of business the day after Election Day.

### **May a voter remedy a provisional ballot that may be rejected?**

A voter must bring their identification before the close of business the day after Election Day.

### **If voters remedy a flawed provisional ballot, how are they notified of this opportunity?**

Voters are not notified.

**What can voters do if they failed to bring ID to the polls?**

Voters must provide identification before the close of business the day after Election Day.

**NOTIFICATION SYSTEM**

**What is the state's Free Notification System to inform voters whether their provisional ballot was counted?**

Wyoming uses an online notification system.

**Who administers the Free Notification System?**

The state administers the system.

**What is the timeline for posting information to the Free Notification System?**

Information is provided after the county canvassing.
