Who Must Appear at the Board Of Elections Within 10 Days to Have Their Provisional Votes Counted?

As a general rule, provisional voters who could not or did not provide one of the required forms of ID and who also did not provide the last four digits of their SSN will have to appear at the board of elections in their respective counties within 10 days after the election and provide the missing ID in order for their vote to count. R.C. 3505.181(B).

A provisional voter who was prevented from voting because of a challenge to his or her eligibility will have to appear at the board within 10 days after the election to give proof of eligibility.

If provisional voter did provide the last four digits of his or her SSN, the board will match that with SSN records to determine whether the vote counts. R.C. 3505.183

R.C. 3505.183 specifies how election boards are to determine whether to count a provisional ballot.
